**Call To Order**

The special call board meeting was called to order by Whitman at 10:25 a.m. for the purpose of Review of Board Legislation, Rules and Regulations Revisions, NIC Conference and RFP Process. Roll call was conducted by Harsin.

A motion was made by McElreath to approve agenda, seconded by Garrett. Motion carried.

Items to consider:

- 73-7-3 Established rule regarding home salon – hours of operation, door remain closed.
- 73-7-13 Outdated, Inactive, Active, Age 70 or older - \$15, Letter of Intent  
Take “wigology” out. #3
- Micropigmentation require a “license” from Board of Health

- Reciprocity class, one-time processing fee.
- Discussion – Trade name change (s)(t)(u)
- Crossover – Barber to cosmetologist vice versa 600 hours, increase hours
- Temporary work permit with military must ask for while applying for licensure.

A motion was made by McElreath to set fines in 73-7-27 a) \$150 - \$600; b) \$600 – 1200, seconded by Harsin; vote: McElreath – yes, Harsin – yes, Garrett – yes, Ennis – no. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath to amend the portion of previous motion regarding a) minimum/no less than \$50 and no more than \$600, seconded by Harsin; vote: Ennis – yes, McElreath – yes, Harsin – yes, Garrett – yes

A motion was made by Garrett at 12:15 p.m. to recess for a 1 hour lunch, seconded by Harsin. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Garrett at 1:40 p.m. to reconvene, seconded by Harsin. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath regarding 73-7-14 Master Certification to change 8 hours to 16 hours, seconded by Garrett; vote: Ennis – yes, McElreath – yes, Garrett – yes, Harsin – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath regarding 73-7-33 to strike “during hours of operation” replace with “at all times while service is being rendered”, seconded by Garrett; vote: Harsin – yes, Ennis – yes, Garrett – yes, McElreath – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath regarding 73-7-37 to reflect Chancery court fines of no less than \$1000 and not to exceed \$5000, seconded by Garrett; vote: Ennis – yes, McElreath – yes, Garrett – yes, Harsin – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath to increase fees as presented in previous bill 1289 from 2013 legislative session, seconded by Harsin; vote: Harsin – yes, McElreath – yes, Ennis – no, Garrett – no, Whitman – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by McElreath to change language of 73-7-16 paragraph 3 to “The Board shall require all schools of cosmetology to only admit students who possess a high school diploma or GED unless enrolled in a high school program,” seconded by Ennis; vote: Garrett – yes, Harsin – yes, McElreath – yes, Ennis – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Garrett regarding 73-7-13 and 73-7-7 to strike “wigology” from statute, seconded by McElreath; vote: Harsin – yes, Garrett – yes, Ennis – yes, McElreath – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Garrett to include in legislation “no apprenticeship”, seconded by Ennis; vote: Harsin – no, McElreath – no, Ennis – yes, Garrett – yes, Whitmans – no. Motion failed.

A motion was made by McElreath regarding 73-7-13 crossover Barber/Cosmetology to increase from 500 to 600 hours, seconded by Harsin; vote: Garrett – yes, Ennis – yes, McElreath – yes, Harsin – yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Garrett regarding Rule 7.3(C) to strike “tight fitting,” seconded by Ennis; vote: McElreath – yes, Ennis – yes, Harsin – yes, Garrett – yes

A motion was made by McElreath regarding Rule 7.3(D) to strike “immediately,” seconded by Harsin; vote: Harsin – yes, Ennis – yes, Garrett – yes, McElreath – yes

A motion was made by McElreath to change the following:

- “toilet facility” to “restroom”
- 7.3(G)(2) – students, employees restroom, at least one for patrons.
- 7.3(G)(5) – shall only have restroom within the confines of the salon business
- 7.3(G)(7) – disposable towels
- 7.8 add (H) – micropigmentation – certification of proficiency and MS State Board of Health certificate
- 7.9(E) – rinsed and placed on clean dry towel for air drying

seconded by Harsin; vote: Garrett – yes, Harsin – yes, McElreath – yes, Ennis – yes. Motion carried.

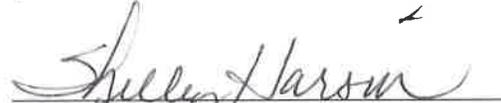
**Adjournment**

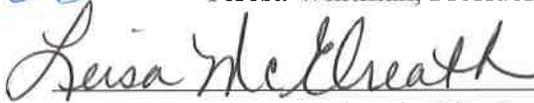
A motion was made by McElreath to adjourn, seconded by Harsin. Motion carried.

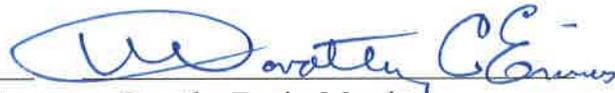
There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 3:52 p.m.

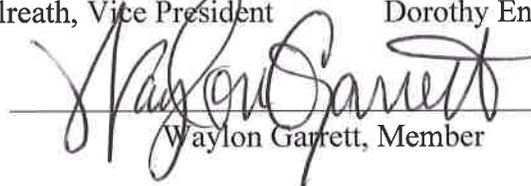
